Communication, Language and Literacy

Our story this half term will be 'Little Raindrop' a book by Autumn Publishing. This book tells a lovely story of a raindrops adventure when it leaves the cloud and falls to the ground.

Through the book we will explore making choices, looking at the weather and showing a preference.

You can support your child at home by sharing books together, learning how to handle books, turning pages and talking with your child about the story and characters.

Using and Applying Mathematics

In maths this term we will be looking at pattern, we will explore patterns in a variety of places such as on materials, in paint and in the natural world.

We will use days of the week and colour of the day as part of our daily routine.



Knowledge and Understanding of the World

This half term is using our senses. We will visit the sensory garden, smell different things to find out if we like them or not. We will explore different textures and sounds.

In art this half term we will be exploring textures and colours as well as pattern and cause and effect.

This term we will be working on our skills in rebound, using core strength and following in instructions. We will be swimming to build our strength and confidence in the water and exercising our muscles in soft play and sensory theatre.
