### **Headteacher Update**

Thank you for your parent view responses. I will post all responses onto our website after half term. In summary:-

95% of parents agree or strongly agree that their child is happy and safe in school. 95% ... agree or strongly agree that their child makes good progress, appropriate to their learning needs and their children are well looked after.

97% ... agree or strongly agree that their child is taught well.

82%... agree or strongly agree that they receive appropriate ideas to support home-learning however, 10% of parents disagree/strongly disagree they do not receive appropriate support and ideas. We will focus on improving this after half term we would like to focus on improving the home-learning support.

97.4% of parents would recommend our school to another parent!

\*Roll out of our new phonics & reading scheme


\*PSHCE curriculum
