This half term our topic is 'This is your life'.

Communication, Language and Literacy

This half term we will have focused communication sessions to promote turn taking, requesting, making choices and oromotor skills every afternoon with communication skills embedded throughout our provision.

We also have our topic book and sensory story for the half term, 'I Like Me', of which we will use in Literacy to support our reading and comprehension.



Every morning we will be completing focused phonics sessions following the Rocket Phonics scheme and using our wonderful reading corner to share stories with adults and peers.

Physical Development

This half term PE will be lead by HTLA Dan and children will access different sessions throughout the week. We will also be having a weekly swimming session working towards our swimming badges.

Other areas of physical development skills will take place through white room slots and outdoor provision.

PSED

In PSED we will be following the Jigsaw scheme starting with the topic 'Being me in my world' as well as working on our individual Oak Targets.

Expressive Arts and Design

In expressive arts and design Oak Trees will be working through their Arts Award which will coincide with the EAD focus of Harvest Festival and Part 1 of the Arts Award: Inspire.

We will also be experimenting with a range of media and materials such as paints and clay as well as exploring the use of tools and how we can manipulate media to create art.

Understanding the World

Following our theme this half term, 'This is your life', we will be looking at ourselves and people around us to discover qualities that make us unique.

Mathematics

In maths this half term we will be developing our understanding of number through one to one correspondence, finding the total of two groups using a number line and writing mathematical statements to solve a mathematical problem.
