  - **Promote access to a wider range of experiences and opportunities in the community for community Inclusion.**

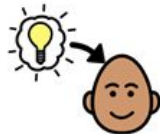

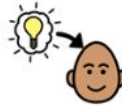

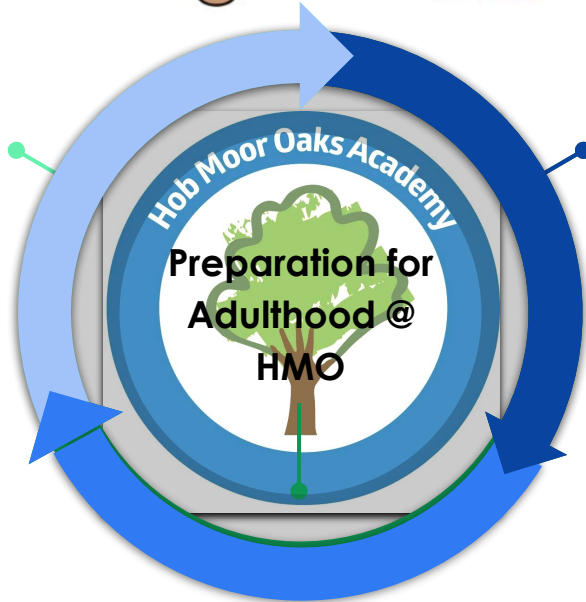
