Dear Parents and Carers,

This week our first group of Year 6 pupils have been to **Lea Green**. They completed activities such as the low ropes, zipline, campfire, soft play, stream walking and canoeing! Everyone arrived back to school looking very tired, but they'd all had a fantastic time!

This will include 2 services which will take place at Hob Moor Oaks - a wheelchair clinic and a wheelchair repair clinic. 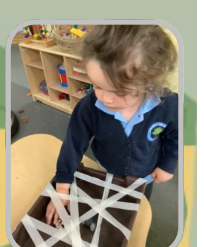
